is designed to remove spoils from barges near the confluence of the Sacramento and Amercian Rivers, and pump Said spoils to the storage site on the Yolo County side of the river. The pipeline has not been used in the last 5 years and future use is believed limited, but the Department of Transportation desires to maintain their rights for future use. Said pipeline easement bisects the "Chart Room" lease, PRC 5603.1 and the Department of Transportation will obtain a letter of consent from the upland owner prior to installation of the portable pipeline.

- 3. Section 101.5 of the Streets and Highways Code is not applicable for the easement. The Department of Transportation will advise staff of material to be removed in the future. Actual removal will be handled under a separate agreement.
- 4. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
- 5. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified env.ronmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.




