#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- Due to a revision of Commission's regulations effective March 1, 1977, this transaction is being changed to comply with current regulations. The modifications by the new regulations include the deletion of the bond provision previously approved and rental reduced from \$75 to \$30 per annum. The rents have been pro-rated accordingly.
- 2. Rent from November 1, 1976 through February 28, 1977, 120 days x \$0.2055/day - \$75/year = \$24.66. Rent from March 1, 1977 through October 31, 1977, 245 days x \$0.0822/ day - \$30/year = \$20.14 and \$30 per annum thereafter.
- 3. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degredation.
- This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.
