GENERAL PERMIT RECREATIONAL USE

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
Two parcels of tide and submerged land containing, 0.06 acres in the Petaluma River, Marin Gounty.

LAND USE: Reconstruction and maintenance of a walkway anif float for recreational use.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Initial period: 10 years from April 1 , 1979.

Public liability insurance: Condined single limit coverage of $\$ 100,000$ ?

CONSIDERATIOON: $\$ 50$ per anrium, with the tite Stare rescrving the right to fix a different rencial on each fifth anniversary of the permit.

BASIS EOR CONSIDERATION:
$\$ 50$ fixed rental for this type of permit.
PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
Applicant is permittee of upland.
Filing fee and first year's rental have been received.

LAND DESCRIPTION
W. 21964

Two parcels of tide and submerged land in the bed of petaluma Creeks situated approximately three miles east of the City of Noyato, Marin County, State of California, said parcels more particularly described as follows:

## PARCEL 1

A strip of land 10 feet in width, lying 5 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

COMMENCING at Station 260 of "Allzrdts High Water Mark", as shown on a map entitled "plat of Tide and Submerged Lands, Adjacent to Right Bank of Petaluma Creek, vicinity of Black Point, Marin County, California," Sheet 2 of 5 , and filed with the State Lands Division, Sacramento', California, thence $S 39^{\circ} 46^{\prime \prime} 27^{\prime \prime}$ E 14 feet to an existing walkway; thence along said walkway N $41^{\circ}$ E 135 feet to a point which is the most southwesterly edge of P.R.C. © 747.1 as said P.R.C. is described and filed with the State Lands Commission in Sacramento, California, said Point also being the POINT OF BEGINNING of the herein described parcel; thence from said posit of beginning and along the southerly line of said P.R.C. 2747.1 , S $52^{\circ}$ E 15 feet to the center of an existing walkway; thence along said wal way $N 38^{\circ} \mathrm{E}$ 190 feet to a point hereinafter referred to as "Point $A$," said "Point $A$ " "also being the end of the herein described centerline.

## PARCEL 2

A strip of land 40 feet in width, lying 20 feet on each side of the following described centerline.

BEGINNING at the above-mentioned "Point A"; thence $N 38^{\circ}$ E 40 feet to the end of the herein described centerline:

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion of Parcels 1 and 2 lying landward of tho ordinary high water mark of Petaluma Creek.
