In accordance with the Commission's delegation of authority to the Executive Officer for the issuance of dredging permits of 10,000 cubic yards or less, Minute Item No. 32, February 24, 1977, permission was gi ated to perform project-related excavation on State-owi 1 lands to the following party:

The permit provides for excavation of 5800 cubic yards of material from granted State-owned tide and submerged lands (minerals reserved in part) in the Oakland Estuary, Alameda County. The purpose of the excavation is to provide a submerged electrical cable crossing between the Cities of Oakland and Alameda. Excavated materials will be removed to authorized disposal sites. The permit provides for payment of a royalty of \$0.15 per cubic yard for material so placed, and \$0.25 in the event material is sold or placed on private property. No royalty is payable for materials removed from within the City of Alameda as no mineral rights were reserved in the Alameda grant. The permit will be effective through July 31, 1980.

In compliance with said delegation of authority, it has been determined that the following conditions have been met:

- 1. The proposed project is categorically exempt from the requirements of CEQA.
- 2. Issuance of the permit and the resultant project will have no significant adverse effect on the environment or the environmental characteristics identified pursuant to Section 63/0.1 et seq., of the P.R.C.
- 3. The dredging amount will not exceed 10,000 cubic yards.

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- 4. A charge per cubic yard will be assessed for spoil; material that is deposited on private property or otherwise lost to future State benefit.
- 5. Approval of the project will be contingent upon approval by all pertinent State, Federal and local agencies

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
