OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. This transaction is occasionad by the acquisition of all the corporate assets and liabilities of assignor, now a dissolved Delaware corporation, by Twentieth Century-Fox Film Corporation. TC-FFC has subsequently reincorporated said assets and liabilities as Pebble Beach Corporation, a subsidiary of TC-FFC. This assignment transfers the lease to the new subsidiary corporation. The office of the Secretary of State advises staff that assignee is qualified to do business in the State.
- This transaction is not a development within the meaning of Section 2503, Article 6.5, 2 Cal. Adm. Code and Section 30106 of the California Coastal Act.
- 3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.
