AUTHORIZATION FOR SALE OF SALVAGED STATE-OWNED ABANDONED PERSONAL PROPERTY

SALVOR:

Mr. Curtis Carley 8270 Blackney Road Sebastopol, Çalifornia 95472

- SALVAGED ITEM: Anchor, shackle and approximately thirty (30) feet of chain cable.
- CONSIDERATION: 25% of the net salvage value of \$25,000 or less, and 50% of the net salvage value in excess of \$25,000. Said sum shall be due on the first of the month following the sale and bear interest at the rate of 7% per annum if not paid within 15 days of the due date. In addition, it is requested that the Commission authorize the Executive Officer the right to approve any sale of the anchor, the final sales price, and the net anchor's salvage value.

BACKGROUND: Mr. Carley, deep sea diver and local resident of the Salt Point area, removed the anchor from the Pacific Ocean at Fisk Mill Cove, Sonoma County, adjacent to Department of Parks and Recreation's property.

> During the process of transporting the anchor to the uplands, Mr. Carley was confronted by Park Rangers who advised him of the State Lands Commission's jurisdiction over the removal and disposal, as well as ownership of the salvaged anchor.

The State Department of Parks and Recreation has advised the Commissions staff that they do not wish to retain the anthor. However, they have expressed a deep concern regarding the continuing salvage disturbance along the Sonoma Coast and will be contacting the Commission's staff in the near future in order to establish long range protection of off-shore artifacts within this area.

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Staff has also contacted and advised the State Office of Historical Preservation regarding the proposed disposition of the anchor. They have advised staff that they have no objection to the sale of the anchor. 32

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In order to allow the Salvor to investigate the potenial market for the anchor, he has been given possession of the anchor with the understanding that the State retains title to the anchor and the right to approve any sale.

The anchor is estimated to be approximately OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION: 70 to 100 years old. Its value is estimated 1. not to exceed \$10,000.

- Staff is currently working with the Salvor to assess the net salvage value 2. of the anchor for the purpose of determing the amount due the State.
- This transaction is exempt for CEQA because it is classified a "non-project". 3.
- This transaction is exempt from the requirements of Art. 6.5 of Title 2, 4. Cal. Adm. Códe in that it is not a development project.




