In accordance with the Commission's delegation of authority to the Executive Officer on February 24, 1977 (Minute Item No. 32), to issue dredging permits of 10,000 cubic yards or less, to perform maintenance dredging on State-owned lands. The following applicant has been granted permission to perform maintenance dredging on State-owned lands:

APPLICANT: Santa Clara County Parks Department

The permit provides for dredging 1500 cubic yards of material from State-owned tide and submerged lands in Steamboat and Alviso Sloughs, Santa Clara County. The purpose of the dredging is to restore and maintain the channel to the County's Alviso Marina. Dredged materials will be spoiled on adjacent County-owned property for levee maintenance and repair. The permit provides for payment of a royalty of \$0.25 per cubic yard in the event material is sold or placed on private property. The permit will be effective from January 15, 1980 through December 31, 1980.

In compliance with said delegation of authority, it has been determined that the following conditions have been met:

1. The proposed project is categorically exempt from the requirements of CEQA, pursuant to the provisions of Section 15104 of the CEQA Guidelines.
2. Issuance of the permit and the resultant project will have no significant adverse effect on the environment or the environmental characteristics identified pursuant to Section 6370.1 et seq., of the P.R.C.
3. The dredging amount will not exceed 10,000 cubic yards.
4. A charge per cubic yard will be assessed for spoil material that is deposited on private property or otherwise lost to future state benefit.

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5. Approval of the project will be contingent upon approval by all pertinent State, Federal and local agencies.

EXHIBIT "A"

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A parcel of tide and submerged land in the state-owned bed of Steamboat and Alviso Sloughs, situate in the County of Santa Clara, State of California, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the Southerly line of Steamboat Slough, said point of beginning being also the Easterly terminus of a course shown as S 72° 25' 30" E, 160.00 feet on that certain amended record of survey recorded July 18, 1963, in Book 163 of maps at Page 19, Santa Clara County Records; thence N 72° 25' 30" W, 160.00 feet, S 71° 26' 30" W, 55.00 feet, S 51° 26' 30" W, 195.00 feet, N 58° 34' 30" W, 125.00 feet, N 35° 14' 51" E, 265.53 feet, S 33° 25' 26" E, 112.27 feet, N 48° 54' 17" E, 105.63 feet, S 62° 30' 43" E, 280.00 feet; thence Southerly across Steamboat Slough S 14° 09' 20" W, 82.81 feet; thence N 54° 12' 54" W, 72.74 feet to the point of beginning.
