GENERAL PERMIT - PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE

APPLICANT: Flint - Brayton Orchards Route 2, Box 300A Oak Way Chico, California 94926

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: 2.07-acre parcel of submerged land in the Sacramento River, located approximately five miles west of Chico, Butte County.

LAND USE: Bank stabilization and protection.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT: Initial period: 25 years from December 10, 1980.

CONSIDERATION: No monetary consideration required. Public benefit will accrue, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION: Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm, Code 2005.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Applicant is owner of upland.

Filing fee and processing costs have been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES: A. P.R.C.: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2; Div. 13.

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B. Cal. Adm. Code: Title 2, Div. 3; Title 14, Div. 6.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

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1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$480.

2. Staff believes that bank protection at this point will be of mutual benefit

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to both the public and applicant. The bank will have additional protection from high water ercision of material at no expense to the public.

- 3. This project is exempt from CEQA: Authority: 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15104, Class 4, minor alteration to land.
- 4. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.
- 5. Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.
- A temporary emergency permit for this project has been issued by the Executive Officer as reported in the Executive Officer's Report at the December 16, 1980 State Lands Commission meeting.




