MODIFICATION OF STATE'S RIGHT OF SURFACE ENTRY

APPLICANT:

AREA, TYPE OF LAND, LOCATION:

Approximately 0.44 acres of escheated lands sold with a 100% mineral reservation to the State, described as lots 5 through 10 inclusive in Block 10, town of Sheridan, as shown on the map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of Placer County. The parcel is a portion of Section 13, T13N R5E, MDM. Sheridan is an unincorporated community on State Highway 55 approximately 30 miles porth of Sacramento.

### PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The surface owner-applicant is currently constructing three single-family residences on the parcel for sale to limited-income buyers through the Federal Farm Home Administration. In order to obtain marketable title to the parcel, the applicant has requested this modification.
- 2. Section 6401(b) of the Public Resources 3ode provides in part that... "upon a finding by the Commission that there are no known deposits of commercially valuable minerals in and above a place located 500 feet below the surface of any land sold...and wherein any...of the mineral deposits... are required by law to be reserved to the State, the commission may by... appropriate instrument, modify the accompanying rights of the State to the use of the surface of such lands, including any right to enter such lands to a depth

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of 500 feet below the surface of such lands, as will permit the orderly use and development of all such sold or exchanged lands".

- 3. A geologic study completed by an acceptable Geotechnical Consulting firm at a cost of \$800 to the applicant, reports that the subject parcel does not contain commercially valuable mineralization. Further, an independent study made by the State Lands Commission's staff concurs with that finding.
- 4. Section 6373 of the PRC provides in part that "Before any disposition of State lands to a private party or other governmental agency, the intended recipient of such lands shall submit to the Commission and to the Legislature a general plan...".
- 5. The Applicant has filed with the Commission's staff topies of the development plan, permits, maps and the geologic report. These hase been distributed as follows:
  - a. One copy of each to the Commissioners of the State Lands Commission;
  - b. One copy of each to the Chief Clerk of the Assembly;
  - c. One copy of such to the Secretary of the Senate.
- 6. This action has been determined to be exempt from the requirements of CEQA since the resulting project is exempt under Class 3.

Authority: PRC 21084, CAC 15103(a).

7. This project is situated on lands not identified as possessing environmental values. A staff review of available environmental information indicates no reason to identify the subject land as having such values at this time.

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- 8. The applicant has also submitted:
  - a) Payment of required filing fee and expense deposit totaling \$125.
  - b) Submission of a geologic report on the area prepared by a registered geologist for applicant at a cost of \$300.

All required approvals and clearances have been obtained for the project and a building permit has been issued by Placer County.

### IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

- 1. FIND THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT IS NOT REQUIRED FOR THE PROJECT AS IT HAS BEEN EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF CEQA AS A CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION, CLASS III.
- 2. FIND THAT THERE ARE NO KNOWN DEPOSITS OF COMMERCIALLY VALUABLE MINERALS IN AND ABOVE A PLANE LOCATED 500 FEET BELOW THE SURFACE OF THE SUBJECT PARCEL, AS DISCLOSED BY INDEPENDENT STUDIES BY A CONSULTING FIRM AND THE COMMISSION'S STAFF.
- AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE A CULTCLAIM DEED TO THOMAS WINN, MODIFYING ANY AND ALL RIGHT TO SURFACE ENTRY THAT THE STATE MAY HAVE TO ENTED UPON A PORTION OF SECTION 13, TL3N, R5E, MDM, PLACEL COUNTY, DESIGNATED AS LOTS 5 THROUGH 10 INCLUSIVE IN BLOCK 10, SHERIDAN, AS SHOWN ON THE MAP THEREOF FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY RECORDER OF PLACER COUNTY AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, IN AND ABOVE A PLANE 500 FEET BELOW THE SURFACE.
