UNITED STATES V. 164.37 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS, SIYUATE IN TUDEUMNE COUNTY, UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT, EASTERN DISTRICT OF CALIFORNIA CIVIL NO. S-80-295-PGM

Several years ago the United States indicated an Interest in acquiring several parcels of school lands located in Tuolumne County as part of the New Melones Drm project. Negotiations with the federal government broke down over language in the mineral reservation. Because of further complications involving a third party claimant to the land, the United States has now filed a condemnation action entitled United States v. 164.37 Acres of land, more or less, <u>strugte</u> in Tuolumne County, United States District Court, Eastern District of California, Civil No. S-80-275-PCW.

The United States has secured an order for immediate possession and has tendered into court the sums of \$23,500 for tract 707 which contains approximately 154 acres and \$1,500 for tract 705 which contains approximately 10 acres. Both tracts are described in Exhibit A and depicted in their approximate location on Exhibit B. The staff of the Commission has determined that the sums offered are equal to or greater than the value of the parcels to be condemned.

It also appears there may be a claim or claim tract 705 adverse to both the United States and the Sr California. However, no other party has appeared in the nation
