- 2. The Los Angeles County Flood Control District has requested temporary ingress and egress over State land in order to repair or reconstruct existing storm drains along Malibu Cove Colony Drive and Malibu Road in Malibu, Los Angeles County.
- 3. This project is exempt from CEQA because it is for temporary ingress and egress only, with no permanent effects on the environment.

Authority: 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15104 Class 4(E).

4. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class C, which authorizes Multiple Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

5. Because the permit will be for temporary ingress and egress over a 6-month period only, it is recommended that the processing fee be waived.
