AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

0.08 acre tide and submerged land in Pacific

Ocean offshore of Crystal Cove, Orange

County.

LAND USE:

Installation and maintenance of kelp test

facility.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period: One year from May 1, 1981.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds

such action to be in the State's best interest.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2005.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is permittee of upland.

Filing fee has been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

A. P.R.C.: Div. 6, Parts 1 and 2; Div. 13; Div. 20.

E. Cal. Adm. Code: Title 2, Div. 3; Title 14, Div. 6.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$550.
- 2. The project consists of installation of an artificial bed for cultivation

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of giant kelp and will be used for experimental and educational purposes.

- 3. This project is exempt from CEQA under Title,14, Cal. Adm. Code Section 15104, Class 4(d) (minor alterations in land, water and vegetation).
- 4. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.K.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class C, which authorizes Multiple Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

5. Because the project will be for temporary research purposes and use of State land will not exceed one year, it is recommended that the processing fee be waived.

- 1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH DOCUMENT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21084, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 1:100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2907.
- 2. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 6.5, OF TITLE 2. OF THE CAL. ADM. CODE.

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- 3. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE P.R.C.
- 4. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO CALIFORNIA STATE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY, POMONA, OF A ONE-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT PUBLIC AGENCY USE, FROM MAY 1, 1981; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT; WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A KELP TEST FACILITY ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
- 5. AUTHORIZE WAIVER OF THE PROCESSING FEE IN THAT THE PERMIT WILL BE FOR TEMPORARY RESEARCH PURPOSES WITH AN EFFECTIVE TERM OF ONE YEAR ONLY.
