T: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company 1260 Fulton Avenue Sacramento, California 95825

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: A 0.413-acre parcel of submerged land in the Sacramento River and a 0.046-acre parcel of submerged land in Mud Creek at its juncture with the Sacramento River in Butte and Glenn Counties.

LAND USE: Right-of-Way 10 feet wide for a submarine telephone cabre:

PRC 5960, from April 15, 1981 across submerged lands of the Sacramento River and Mud Creek near Chico. Due to unforeseen problems, Pacific Telephone now finds it necessary to relocate its proposed submarine cable crossing of the Sacramento River approximately 2000 feet northerly of the previously authorized location.

- 2. The annual rental value of the sites is estimated to be \$200.
- 3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

- 4. Staff has coordinated this project with interested agencies and organizations. They have found this project to be without objection as long as any damaged areas are restored.
- 5. The staff concludes that this project falls within the exemptions specified in Cal. Adm. Code Section 15103, Class 3, new construction of small facilities.
