#### DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT:

Santa Fe - Pomeroy, Inc.

500 Hopper Street

Petaluma, California 94952

AREA, TYPE LAND AND EOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands in the bed of the Petaluma River at the confluence of McNear Canal, Petaluma, Sonoma County.

LAND USE:

Dredge & maximum of 30,000 cubic yards of sand, silt and gravel from McNear Canal and its confluence with the Federal channel in the Petaluma River and deposit spoils on approved upland disposal site on applicant's

premises.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period: 5 years from July 1,

CONSIDERATION:

Royalty of \$0.25 per cubic yard for materials removed from the bed of the Petaluma River and sold or placed on private property.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing fee and processing costs have been

received.

- 1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH DOCUMENT IS NOT REOUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21084, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2907.
- 2. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE P.R.C.
- 3. AUTHORIZE THE STAFF TO ISSUE TO SANTA FE POMEROY, INC. THE DREDGING PERMIT ON FILE IN THE OFFICES OF THE COMMISSION. SAID PERMISSION SHALL BE ISSUED IN CONSIDERATION OF ROYALTY FOR DREDGED MATERIAL OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD PLACED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY, SOLD, OR USED FOR PRIVATE OR COMMERCIAL BENEFIT. SAID PERMIT SHALL BE FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS BEGINNING JULY 1, 1981, AND SHALL ALLOW THE DREDGING OF A MAXIMUM OF 30,600 CUBIC YARDS OF SAND, SILT AND GRAVEL, EXCLUDING ALL OTHER MINERALS INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, OIL, GAS AND GEOTHERMAL, FROM AN AREA OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED

LANDS IN THE PETALUMA RIVER AT ITS CONFLUENCE WITH MCNEAR CANAL, SONOMA COUNTY. SAID AREA IS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO AND BY THIS REFERENCE EXPRESSLY MADE A PART HEREOF. MATERIALS DREDGED SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN AN APPROVED UPLAND DISPOSAL SITE.

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
