OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

The proposed project will consist of replacing the existing wooden bridge

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crossing Morgan Slough near Ferndale, California with a 150-foot long, 24-fkot wide precast concere tee beam bridge that services two dairy farms in the area.

The vertical clearance will be ten feet above the mean low water line.

- 2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$70.
- 3. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 14 Cal. adm. Code, Div. 6, Section 15102, Class 2, which exempts the replacement of an existing structure or facility, where he new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced.
- 4. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.J. 6370.1, and is classified in the category, Class A, which authorizes Restricted Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. The have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.


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
