The State Lands Commission authorized Fuelbreak Agreement PRC 5813.9 with the Uniteia States Department of Agriculture; Forest Service at its meeting in Aptil, 1980 (Minute Iten) No. C2, April 24, 1980). The Commisston lin consideration of the benefits to the State school land under its jurisdtction consented to the construction and maintenance of a fuelbreak by the Forest Service. The Agrement permitted a fuelbreak: 200 feet in width across school land in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NEt, Section 36; T9S, R23E, MDM, in Fresno County, Its term commenced $4 / 24 / 80$, for a ten year period, ani terminates Aprill 23 ; 1990 .

In late July, 1981 the Forest Service applied to amend Fuelbreak Agreement - PRC 5813.9 to include prescribed burning on the 28-acre poition of the subjeet NHW NE忩; lying northeasterly of the existing fuelbreak. The term. of the prescribed burning amendment was requested to have a termination date of Apria 23, 1990 common with the Fuelibreak Agreement. The Forest Service has planned 230 -acre helfteorch prescribed burn on adjacent National Forest land, as part: of their continuing fuel reduction program in Jose Basin, vicinity of the highly developed Shaver take area. The burn will be on at opportunity basis in 1981-82. The fuellbreak on the school land is an fintegral part of the control lind for this 350 -acre burn project. The 28 -acres of school land upor which prescribed burning authorization is desixem by the Forest Service lies between the fuelbreak and the National Forest land. Inclusion of prescribed burning of. the 28 -acres will provide a continuous area totalling 2,0 pp acres where highly flammable chaparral vegetative cover will have been treated.

The Forest Service will artifically seed burned areas with; annual/peremnial grasses, as needed, if it is determined that insufficient natural seed exists. Periodic treatiment. of fuels to maintain fuel loading at a moderate leyel is planned. Addit ional benefits: (1) A public need will be served by reducing the severity of wildfires and, also, protecting State and privale property and resource values and (2) It is viewed, direst benefits will acerue to wild life populations and diversity is a result of the prescribed burn project on all lands breated.

The proposed amendment of Fuelbreak Agreemènt - PRC 581 , 9 does not convey any interest in real property; it provides a cooperative arrangement whereby the Scate contributes a portion of its land and the Forest Service will condut prescribed burning, artifjetal seeding of grasses and petiodic treatment of fuels upon a portion thereof.

The existing Exhibits "A-1" and "A-2" in the original agreement are deleted and new Exhibits "B-1" and "B-2" substituted therefore in the amended agreement, Said Exhibits "B-1": and "B-2" are attached.

All other terms and conditions of the original Agreemedt shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
