## GEOTHERMAL RESOURCE LEASES REVIEW OF MATCHING BIDS

On June 24, 1981 the State Lands Commission authorized staff to offer three parcels totaling 1,480 acres of State reserve mineral lands in Lake, Mendocino and Sonoma Counties for lease by competitive public bid for the extraction of geothermal resources. These lands were subsequently offered for lease on the basis of a net profits bid factor. In addition to the net profits payment, the lease provided for the payment of a 12.5 percent royalty on gross revenue received for the sale of steam and an annual rental of \$1 per acre.

Nine bids (three for each parcel) were submitted on October 1, 1981 and on October 30, the Commission determined that Central California Power Agency was the highest qualified bidder on all three parcels with their bids of 97.5 percent on Lease Sale 1, 80.1 percent on Lease Sale 2 and 70 percent on Lease Sale 3, all other bids were rejected.

The surface landowners for each of the respective parcels, having been notified of the subject bids, have now exercised their rights to match the high 't acceptable bid within the time prescribed by P.R.C. 12. The matching bids are presently being reviewed by staff for legal, technical and economic qualification.

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
