OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The upland owner, Glenn Colusa Trrigation District, has given its consent to the permittee by letter dated March 22, 1972.
- Section 2 of the lease conforms to the Lyon/Fogerty decision.
- 3. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received:

WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE PERMIT; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$100,000; FOR A RECREATIONAL BOAT FACILITY ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

A 57 foot by 43 foot rectangular marcel of land in the bed of Sacramento River. situated in the County of Tehama, State of California, being easterly of that portion of Lot 100 of Subdivision No. 2 of the Capay Rancho of Tehama County, the easterly edge of said rectangular parcel being parallel with and 10 feet distant easterly of the easterly edge of an existing dock.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary low water mark of the Sacramento.
