## ACCESS TO BUTTE CREEK, COLYISA COUNTY closing of laux rold

At its November 23, 1981 meeting, the Commissjon askej for an update of the situation involving the closure of Laux Road, Colusa County, which was purportedly the only access to a twelve mile reach os Bưtite Crieek. On Novemberi 24 , 1981, the Colusa County Board of Supervisors voted to keep Laux Road closed. They also indicated that they would welicime the intervention of the State Lands Comission or other State agencies if it is felt that the closure was illegai. Informal contacts with the Department of Fish and Game and the Department of Boating and Waterways indicate that both agencies may be interested in a lawsuit challenging the ciosure of Laux Road.
