RENTAL SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND ISSUANCE OF GENERAL LEASE - COMMERCIAL USE

APPLICANT:

Vernon O. and Caroline M. Bradshaw

Star Route, Box 218-A

Rio Vista, California 94571

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 0.587-acre parcel of tide and submerged land in Mayberry Slough, Sacramento County.

LAND USE:

Commercial marina.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 20 years from April 1,

1981.

Surety bond:

\$5,000.

Public liability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of \$300,000.

CONSIDERATION:

\$680 per annum with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease. This lease was negotiated and executed prior

to January 1, 1982.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2005.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is lessee of upland.

Filing fee, current rental and the recommended rental settlement of \$1,300 has been received.

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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Staff and proposed lessee have agreed that as settlement for the unauthorized use of State-owned land for the period April 1, 1968 through March 31, 1981 to pay the sum of \$1,300.
- 2. This project is exempt from CEQA because it is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905, Class 1, which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair.
- 3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use. The prject as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.

LAND DESCRIPTION

A parcel of tide and submerged land in the bed of Mayberry Slough approximately three miles easterly of the confluence of the Sacramento and San Joaquin Rivers, Sacramento County, State of California, described as follows:
