Installation and maintenance of a floating platform to support a hydroelectric generation

Initial period: 25 years from May 1, 1982.

CONSIDERATION:

\$250 per annum with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Applicant is lessee of upland.

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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The applicant proposes to construct a 200 KW hydroelectric generation unit utilizing energy of the natural fall of the water. Since the State may be interested in this type of energy at a future date, the applicant has agreed to submit an annual performance analysis relative to the unit.
- Section 2 of the lease conforms to the Lyon/Fogerty decision.
- 3. A Negative Declaration was prepared and certified by the Sutter County Planning Department, pursuant to CEQA and the State EIR Guidelines. The Sutter County Planning Department found that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 4. The project is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in use category "Class B", which authorizes Limited Use. The project as proposed will not have a significant effect on identified environmental values.


## STATEMENT OF PEASONS TO SUPPORT FINDING OF NEGATIVE DECLARATION Sutter County Project No. SUT-1327 - American Enertech ...

- Impact of Structure (42' by .4' boat and walkways) Visual to be
  painted in earth tones to blend with surrounding landscape.
  Total visual impact unavoidable.
- Flood Plain & Water Flow Will not cause water damming or diversion.

  Debris guard and periodic patrol will insure that flows of water past the project can be maintained. The boat will not be accessable from land when water leaves the normal charnel.
- River Transportation & Recreation The structure will not excessively block the river channel for transportation or recreational use.

  (Approximately 54 feet encroachment into a 250 foot wide low level channel 21.6%)
- Wildlife & Habitat No effect.
- Impact of Barriers (Walkway entrance fences) No significanc impact. Fences are intended only to control access to the structure.
- Impact of Traffic Approximately 2 to 4 trips per day; security and maintenance purposes. Structure will not impede traffic within the river. Adequate road access is provided.
- Impact of Power Transmission New facilities to be installed pursuant to Pacific Gas & Electric Company requirements. Overhead lines proposed with adequate clearances, shielding and switching provided. Major power transmission by existing lines. An on-board computor will be used to monitor power output, as well as river flows.
- All of the working equipment will be enclosed within a structure. A 20 gauge steel structure can reduce noise by 20-22 db. Anticipated noise level at the outside of the structure reduced to 70 db at full production. This level is acceptable for recreational and agricultural use. All residential uses in the area are on the landward side of the levee and are separated by an earth berm. The nearest public road is 250 feet away. The noise level to these areas will be less than 50 db and will not be significant.
- Impact of Lighting and Safety Intake and exhaust guards are to be provided for the raceway. All moving parts will be enclosed

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within a locked structure. Access gates and wing fences will control land access to the unit. Photo electric controlled security lights will be installed if deemed necessary. Photo electrically controlled navigation lights will be installed. Warning and "keep off" signs should be posted on the structure and the gates and fences. The facility will be patrolled daily by security and maintenance personnel.

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
