## ANNEXATION OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, CITY OF OCEANSIDE, SAN DIEGO COUNTY

The State Lands Comnission has received a request from San Diego LAFCO to review and approve the annexation and boundaries of the proposed Camp Pendleton Annexation.
This area involved approximately $125,478 \pm$ acres of upland and $33,672 \pm$ acres of tide and submerged lands and would include the United States Marine Corps base Camp Pendleton, the San Dnofre Nuclear: Power Plant and three parcels of State Parks and Recreation larids which total $2,868.6 \pm$ acres.

Pursuant to Government Code Seciion 35009, the Commission is to review and approve or deny the proposed annexation and annexation boundaries as appropriate and correct.

The staff of the Commission has reviewed tie proposed annexation boundary description and finds it adequate. Furthermore, staff has no objection to transfer of local police power jurisdiction from the county to the city and, therefore, submits the recommendations of approval below.
