OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

The applicant proposes to repair a natural rock promontory by replacing rock in a gap that was created by wave erosion. The rock promontory is used as a launching point for surfers and divers and is also used by surf fisherman. The promontory also acts as a natural groin which helps to retain sand on the adjoining public beach.

The repair work is being done through private contributions. The County has accepted responsibility for routine maintenance, not exceeding \$500 per year, after improvements are completed.

- The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$50.
- This project is exempt from CEQA, pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905, Class 2, because it involves the reconstruction of a damaged structure.
- The project is situated on lands identified. as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in use category "C" which authorizes Multiple Use. The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.
