SJBVENTIONS TO CITIES AND COUNTIES FOR THE 1982-83 FISCAL YEAR

DESCRIPTION: F.R.C. Section 6817 provides for subventions of State tide and submerged land oil and gas revenues to cities and counties, under conditions described below, and requires the State Lands Commission to report to the state controller the amounts of revenues to be us'sd for purposes of calculating subventions.

OTHER PERTINENT
INFORMATION:

1. The subventions shall be made to cities or counties that own or operate parks (public beaches) free of charge to the public for recreational purposes. Prior to January 1, 1976, the statute required that qualifying parks be immediately adjacent to and have a common frontage with state tides and submerged land leased for oil and gas. As of January 1, 1976. due to the enactment of Chapter 1210., Statutes of 1975.

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the adjacency and common Erontage requirements were removed for cities. Beach parks and State oil and gas lecises may now be non-contiguous, alchough within a city's corporate limits, with Che city qualifying for subventions
2. The subvention for each fiscal year shall amount to one percent of the State's total revenue from orfsthore oil and gas leases located withia the Youndaries of the respective city or county to a maximum of $\$ 75,000$ for each mile or fraction of a mile of qualifying beach.
3. With respect to each city or county, the apportionment for any given fiscal year shall be based upon the physical facts existing on June 30 of the preceding fiscal year.
4. Certifications required by P.R.C. Section 6817 have been made by each of che subventionees for Fiscal Year 1982-83.
5. The State Lands Commission shall, at the cime of remitting revenues to the State Tresurer, report to the State Controller the total amount of revenue received from tide and submerged lands shown with respect to each cicy or county to which such amount is applicable.
