1. The proposed renewal lease will reflect the following:
a. Incorporation of expiring leases (PRC 3891.1 and PRC 3811.1) into PRC 3811.1, as both use areas are leased by Exxon for a single operation.
b. A revised annual rental payment tased on $\$ .02$ per diameter inch per linear foot of pipeline. The volumetric rental alternative was examined and found inapplicable to this lease since the applicant has not used the line for nearly five years and has no plans to do so in the foreseeable future.
c. Modified lease description to update the lease area to the present use.
d. Three ten-year options exercised simultaneously for a term of 30 years (Lease PRC 3811,1).
2. Lessee agrees tó submit a Quitclaim Deed relative to Lease PRC 3811.1, General Lease - Right-of-Way Use, that Pexpired on August 20, 1982.

4. The project is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in use category "B" which authorizes Limited Use., The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmentar values.
