AUTHORIZATION TO SELL STATE-OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY

BACKGROUND:

After unauthorized Jalvors removed scrap metal items, composed of a large percentage of copper and brass, from the SS Ohioan, a sunken vessel located beneath ungranted gate National Recreationa' Area (GGNRA), employees of GGNRA intercepted the salvors and seized the salvaged items. They are being retained on the State's behalf until The salvor applied for a salvage permit to salvage more items from the Ohioan; per Calendar Item 18 of the March 24, 1983 commission meeting until such time as a public agency application (National Park Service) can be negotiated and resolved.

CURRENT SITUATION:

Staff requests that the Commission give staff the discretion to sell all items, not found to be historically or culturally significant, as scrap metal at current

market prices. Prior to a sale, the items would be inspected and their significance determined by an archaeologist from the Department of Parks and Recreation. The procee derived from the sale would be distributed in accordance with Section 2. Title 2, Div. 3, Chap. 1, Cal. Adm. Code.
