LAND DESCRIPTION

PRC 3903

A parcel of tide and submerged land 20 feet wide in the bed of the San Joaquid River adjacent to Jersey Island, Contra Costa County, California, lying 10 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

COMMENCING at C. & G.S. triangulation station "Blume 1931" having California Zone II coordinates of Y = 136,895.72 and X \pm 2,080,574.10, thence S 6° 00' E, 3,550 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING, thence N 6° 00' N, 50 feet to the terminous of the herein described centerline.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the San Joaquin River.

Bearings, distances and coordinates in the above description are based upon the Callifornia Coordinate System. Zone II.
