DENIAL OF APPLICATION FOR DREDGING PERMIT

During consideration of Calendar Item 17, attached, Assistant Executive Officer Jim Trout indicated that since preparation of this item, the applicant has agreed to issuance of a one year dredging permit.

Upon motion made by Commission-Alternate Ordway and seconded by Commission-Alternate Wallace, the following Resolution was approved by a vote of 2-0:

THE COMMISSION:

- 1. FINDS THAT THIS ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061 AS A CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT PROJECT, CLASS 4, MAINTENANCE DREDGING, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15304(g).
- 2. AUTHORIZES STAFF TO ISSUE TO SELDEN L. PERRY THE DREDGING PERMIT ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSION. SAID PERMIT SHALL ALLOW DREDGING A MAXIMUM VOLUME OF 10,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN A DREDGER CUT OFF THE MOKELUMNE RIVER AND DISPOSAL BEHIND AND ADJACENT TO THE LEVEE SYSTEM ON PERRY'S ISLAND. A ROYALTY OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED FOR MATERIAL PLACED ON THE APPROVED ADJACENT UPLAND SITE. SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITIES CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.

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DENIAL OF APPLICATION FOR DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT:

Selden L. Perry P. O. Box 375

Isleton, California 95641

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands in a dredger cut off the Mokelumne River between Andrus Island and Perry's Island, Sacramento County.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The applicant has applied for a ten-year mainterace dredging permit to authorize periodic dredging of a maximum volume of 1,000 cubic yards of material per year for the purpose of maintaining an adequate depth in the channel for passage of recreational vessels to berth and dry dock at Perry's Marina as shown on Exhibit "B". The dredged material was proposed for disposal behind and adjacent to the levee system on Perry's Island.

Staff has discussed with Mr. Perry the issuance of a one-year permit at a royalty rate of \$0.25 per cubic yard until such time the dredging may be incorporated within the terms of the marina lease which is currently being negotiated for renewal.

Mr. Perry has objected to issuance of a one-year permit, which he feels is inappropriate authorization for such periodic dredging of less than 1,000 cubic yards of material per year, because such action would

require annual renewal prior to such time the dredging may be included within the terms of the marina lease. Staff is, therefore, recommending the application for a ten-year permit be denied without prejudice.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a statutory exempt project because CEQA does not apply to projects which a public agency rejects or disapproves.
