APPROVAL OF A GRAZING LEASE

APPLICANT:

Mrs. Dorothy Waid

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 240+-acre parcel of sovereign land, located

in the bed of Goose Lake, Modoc County.

LAND USE:

Cattle grazing.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: Ten years beginning March 1,

1986.

Public liability insurance: Combined single

limit coverage of \$300,000.

CONSIDERATION: \$240 per annum; with the State reserving the

right to fix a different rental on each fifth

anniversary of the lease.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The applicant proposes to graze cattle on a seasonal basis over the lands within the bed of Goose Lake contiguous to the applicant's fee uplands. Terms of the lease restrict grazing use to that which the land can support.
- 2. This activity involves lands which have NOT been identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. However, the Commission has declared that all tide and submerged lands are "significant" by nature of their public ownership (as opposed to "environmental significant"). Since such declaration of significance is not based upon the requirements and criteria of P.R.C. 6370, et seq., use classifications for such lands have not been designated. Therefore, the finding of the project's consistency with the use classification as required by 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2954 is not applicable.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land, 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(d)(1).

GRAZING LEASE BEGINNING MARCH 1, 1986; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$240, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH: ANNIVERSARY OF THE LEASE; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$300,000; FOR CATTLE GRAZING ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
