OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$572.23.
- Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structure (dock and pilings) and Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land (riprap), 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(c)(1) and 2905(d)(2).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300, and 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

- 3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. but will not affect those significant lands.

All that tide and submerged land in the bed of the Sacramento River at River Mile Post 70.8 lying immediately beneath a floating dock, walkway, ramp, and riprap placed for bank protection, TOGETHER WITH a necessary use area extending 10 feet from the extremities of said dock and walkway, said structures and riprap being located along the left bank of the Sacramento River and adjacent to and waterward of that land described in the Grant Deed recorded March 31, 1983 in Book 83-03-31, Page 1790, Official Records of Sacramento County.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the Sacramento River.
