OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

 Historically, three separate, sequential permits were authorized and issued for the subject facilities to three separate sequential ownerships in the littoral upland without the permits being either assigned to the subsequent owner or terminated. The permittee of the third and last permit has refused to assign said permit to applicant.

The termination of these permits will be an administrative action which clarifies the Commission's records and does not change or enlarge the estate or use from that granted in the subject permits.

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2. The upland is improved with a six-unit motel known as The Holiday House. The subject facilities are utilized as an accommodation for the owner and guests of the motel.

3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. 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
