#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. At its meeting on January 26, 1978 (Minute Item No. 24) the Commission authorized issuance of a master gas pipeline lease to P.G. & E. covering their then existing 89 State Lands leases. P.G. & E. has now applied to the Commission for an amendment to the lease to add a new parcel for a six—inch underwater pipeline crossing at White Slough, San Joaquin County.
- 2. Pursyant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structure, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15303.

Authority: P.R.C. 21084 and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the activity is consistent with its use classification.

Station "Grass-1931", said N.O.S. station having California Coordinate System, Zoive 3 coordinates of N=589,521.38 and E=1,720,041.13; thence from said point of beginning S 17 ° 28' 55" E 630.34 feet to the end of the herein described line.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water marks of White Slough.
