AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: State school land - S1/2, NE1/4 Section 16, T11N, R1E, SBB&M, San Bernardino County, fourteen miles northeast of Barstow.

LAND USE: Prospecting for valuable minerals.

TERM:

Prospecting permit was issued effective August 1, 1984 for a term of two years. Permittee has requested quitclaim of the permit effective February 19, 1986.

**REASON FOR QUITCLAIM:** 

ASARCO has performed geologic mapping and geochemical sampling on their lode claims on adjacent sections 15 and 22. The exploration results coupled with the current depressed precious metals market and curtailed exploration budget has caused ASARCO, Inc. to lose interest in the State prospecting permit and adjacent area. Although the permit would expire July 31, 1986, ASARCO does not desire to maintain the permit and associated liability for the property.

#### PREREQUISITE ITEMS:

A. Quitclaim deed duly executed by Permittee.

B. Permittee has complied with paragraph 18 of the permit which requires restoration of the land, as nearly as possible, to the condition existing on the date the permit took effect.

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
