OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The sovereign land described in the proposed lease was formerly let to Rivelco, Inc., a firm without any known affiliation with the present applicant. Rivelco sold its upland parcel to the applicant, as evidenced by a deed recorded in 1983. The applicant continued to pay the rent and to perform under the terms of the lease until it expired, as of November 20, 1985. Upon notice from the staff, the applicant submitted an application for a new lease, to continue grainloading operations.
- Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities, 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(a)(2).

OF A 25-YEAR GENERAL LEASE INDUSTRIAL USE BEGINNING NOVEMBER 20, 1985; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$495, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LEASE; PROVISION OF A \$15,000 SURETY BOND; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$2,000,000; FOR ONE TWO-PILE DOLPHIN, TWO THREE-PILE DOLPHINS, ONE FOUR-PILE DOLPHIN, AND BELT CONVEYOR ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

EXHIBIT "A"

LAND DESCRIPTION

WP 562

A parcel of tide and submerged land adjacent to the left bank of the Sacramento River, Sacramento County, California, commencing approximately 670 feet downstream from the highway bridge at Isleton and extending 120 feet downstream, said parcel of tide and submerged land having a width of 85 feet from the line of ordinary high water into the Sacramento River.
