CALENDAR ITEM

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REVOCATION OF APPROVAL OF A PROSPECTING PERMIT FOR MINERALS OTHER THAN OIL, GAS, GEOTHERMAL RESOURCES, SAND AND GRAVEL, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY

APPLICANT:

Floyd M. Whitson 913 11th Street Golden, Colorado 80401

PRDPOSED ACTION:

Revoke the approval of issuance of a prospecting permit which was to run for two years to prospect for precious and other valuable minerals, other than oil, gas, geothermal resources, sand and gravel on 640 acres of land, more or less, in San Bernardino County.

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

State school land, Section 16, T18N-R13E, SBM, San Bernardino County, approximately 15 miles north of Mountain Pass.

PROPOSED ACTION:

On November 29, 1964, the Commission approved the issuance of a mineral prospecting permit to Floyd M. Whitson for this State school land parcel. The two-phased project description entailed the augering of four holes to a depth of 100 feet and bulk sampling of 250 tons of sediments with a backhoe/loader. The Commission's approval of issuance was contingent upon the deliverance of a \$7,000 performance bond by the applicant in favor of the State. Paragraph 29 of the prospecting permit executed by Mr. Whitson

required the furnishing and maintenance of the bond within 30 days of the approval date of the issuance of the permit by the Commission. Mr. Whitson has been unsuccessful in his attempts to obtain the \$7,000 bond. believes they have been more than reasonable in allowing Mr. Whitson additional time beyond the 30 days in which to obtain his bond. Without the bond, Staff did not deliver the permit form to the Chief of the Extractive Development Program for execution, and thus the permit was never issued. Staff now recommends that the Commission revoke the approval of the issuance of a permit to Mr. Whitson as it is in the best interest of the State to make this parcel of State school land available to any other interested party.


