Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities, 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(a)(2).

FRANCIS YACHT CLUB OF A 15-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT RECREATIONAL USE BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1986; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$636, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE PERMIT; WITH PROVISION OF A \$500 SURETY BOND; AND WITH PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$500,000; FOR MAINTENANCE OF 12 BOAT MOORING BUOYS UTILIZED FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
