OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that these activities are exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as categorical exempt projects. These projects are exempt under Class 1 (Existing Facilities, Items Nos. A, B, C and D), and Class 3 (New Construction, Item Nos. E and F), 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

- 2. These activities involve lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the projects as proposed are consistent with the lands' use classification.
- 3. Lake Tahoe Application: The Commission at its meeting on Nowmber 27, 1978, suspended all leasing for new construction at Lake Tahoe, except for mooring buoys in designated areas. Inis action was taken pending completion of an EIR which addresses the cumulative impact of continued construction of piers in Lake Tahoe. The application herein Item C is for the continued use of an existing pier and buoy in the lake, and therefore is not subject to the Commission's suspension of leasing activities for new construction.
- 4. All permits covering structures in Lake Tahoe will include a condition subsequent that if any structure authorized is found to be in nonconformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone ordinance and if any alterations, repairs, or removal required pursuant to said ordinance are not accomplished within the

designated time period, then the permit will be automatically terminated, effective upon notice by the State and the site shall be cleared pursuant to the terms thereof.

5. PRC 5281 (Item C) and WP 5350 (Item D) were originally General Permits — Recreational Use, but now qualify for rent-free permits pursuant to Section 6503.5 of the P.R.C. For PRC 5281 the upland ownership was changed to the parties listed on Exhibit "A" effective May 24, 1985
