TERMINATION OF NONCOMMERCIAL LEASE PRC 5212 AND ISSUANCE OF GENERAL PERMIT - RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANT:

San Joaquin Delta Power

Squadron P. O. Box 8203

Stockton, California 95208

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 0.997-acre area of tide and submerged land lying in the filled and unfilled natural bed of

the old channel of the San Joaquin River, located adjacent to Headreach Island,

San Joaquin County.

LAND USE:

Reconstruction and maintenance of facilities

utilized for social, instructional and charitable activities related to yachting.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE:

Initial period: Ten years beginning

November 1, 1976.

Renewal options: Two successive periods of

ten years each.

Surety bond: \$1,000.

RubTic liability insurance: Combined single

limit coverage of \$300,000.

Consideration:

\$880 per annum; five-year

rent review.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period:

25 years beginning

November 1, 1986.

Surety bond:

\$3,000.

Public liability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of \$500,000.

Special:

- 1. The permit prohibits the utilization of the facilities for residence purposes.
- 2. The permit is conditioned on the rights of the United States of America to place spoil material on the premises, and to perform all other rights previously conveyed by the State of California for the San Joaquin River and Stockton Channel project.

CONSIDERATION: \$880 per annum; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the permit.

Pursuant to 2 Car. Adm. Code 2003.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Filing fee has been received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. At its meeting on December 15, 1976, the State Lands Commission, in Minute Item 8, approved the issuance of Noncommercial Lease PRC 5212 for a floating dock and walkway.

Applicant is a private, nonprofit unincorporated entity organized to promote y chting. One of the the various services provided by the organization is a public boating course for the enhancement and development of navigational and boating skills. The original lease is not consistent with the Commission's current formats, rules and regulations. Termination of the original lease is recommended.

The improvements in the proposed permit consist of a floating dock and ramp, a concrete pad improved with a wooden platform and patio roof, and a concrete pad with barbecue grills. All facilities currently exist except for the wooden platform and patio roof which are to be reconstructed.

2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities (floating dock and ramp, concrete pad, and concrete pad/barbecue grills) and Class 2, Reconstruction or Replacement (wooden platform and patio roof), 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(a)(2) and 2905(b).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300, and 2 Cal Adm. Code 2905

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the activity is consistent with its use classification.

BEGINNING at a point on the southerly boundary of PARCEL SEVENTY as described in deed recorded in Book 3329 page 1 of Official Records in the Office of the County Recorder of San Joaqu. n County, said point being the westerly terminous of that certain course described as N 83° 37' W 456 feet in said deed; thence along said southerly boundary S 83° 37' E 206 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continuing along said southerly boundary S 83° 37' E 120 feet; thence leaving said southerly boundary, South 364.06 feet; thence N 86° .0' W 50.60 feet; thence N 78° 51' W 70.10 feet; thence North 360.47 feet to the point of beginning.
