OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Mineral prospecting permit PRC 6742 was approved for issuance to Kaiser Steel Corporation by the Commission on October 25, 1984, effective December 1, 1984.

During the initial two year term of the prospecting permit, Kaiser Steel Corporation performed geologic mapping, rock chip sampling and shallow soil sampling. This work was performed concurrently with prospecting on land owned or held by Kaiser in a lårge study area. Results of this investigation indicate the potential for a precious metals open pit orebody centered on patented land owned by Kaiser within State Section 36. orebody is believed to extend onto State land within the confines of mineral prospecting permit PRC 6742 and such land would likely be included in any development plan. Additional drilling is planned on Kaisers patented land to determine the areal extent of any open pit orebody. Kaiser Steel Corporation requests the additional one year extension of mineral prospecting permit PRC 6742 to perform additional surface sampling to further delineate the orebodies extension onto State land. Staff recommends the one year extension to be in the best interest of the State.
