OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- The Waddell Bluffs is an area in Santa Gruz County on State Highway Route 1, where talus rock material continually falls onto the Highway Right-of-Way. The California Department of Transportation has found that the most economic method of safely disposing of material is to periodically deposit it in the surf zone adjacent to the Those doposits are made annually Bluffs. during the months of heavy storms and tidal conditions, thereby allowing wave action to disperse the material as was done naturally prior to Kighway construction. This talus material is a Santa Cruz mudstone that is brittle, and is converted by wave action into sandy material that is transported downcoast and dispersed along existing beach areas. Staff contacted the Department of Parks and Recreation (regional manager and Headquarters personnel) to verify that Department of Parks and Recreation is aware of the proposed California Department of Transportation project. Staff was informed that Parks has knowledge of the project, and has no objection.
- The a/nnual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$297.
- 3. An environmental analysis document was prepared, circulated, and adopted for this project by the California Coastal Commission, Central Coast Area as provided under P.R.C. 21080.5 and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15251(c).

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The staff of the State Lands Commission has reviewed such environmental analysis document and believes that the conditions have been met for the Commission to use the document as an EIR substitute as a Responsible Agency as provided under 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15253.

- 4. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OF A 25-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT PUBLIC AGENCY USE BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1987; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR DISPOSAL OF TALUS SLIDE MATERIAL INTO THE SURF ZONE ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
