DESERT AREA EXCHANGE WITH BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT

Isolated school lands in the desert form the majority of the Commission's asset in land. Most are remote, without development potential, and surrounded by Bureau of Land Management (BLM) lands. Many have sensitive environmental attributes preventing their use as revenue sources for STRS. Most have been determined by staff to have little or no mineral values.

The staff is preparing a large exchange proposal which offers BLM up to 50,000 acres of scattered desert school sections (40 to 640 acres in size) in exchange for about 5,000 acres in the vicinities of Barstow, Victorville and Yucca Valley. The selected BLM lands will have much higher value and much better development, lease or sale potential than the school sections proposed for passing to BLM.

When the exchange package is finalized, the staff will present it to the Commission for approval or denial.
