AWARD OF THE ROYALTY OIL SALES CONTRAGT, STATE OIL AND GAS LEASES PRC 3033 AND PRC 3413, HUNTINGTON BEACH FIELD, ORANGE COUNTY

On November 20, 1986 the Commission authorized the competitive bid sale of royalty oil produced from State oil and gas Leases PRC 3033 and PRC 3413, Huntington Beach Field, Orange County. The royalty oil is presently being purchased by Champlin Petroleum Company under a contract which will expire on July 1, 1987.

Champlin Petroleum Company is paying the State under this contract a bonus of \$0.733 per barrel above a base price essentially equivalent to the highest price posted in the Huntington Beach Field. The State's share of production from these leases is approximately 13,000 barrels per month of 20.89 API gravity crude oil.

On December 5, 1986 the staff offered by competitive public bidding the royalty production from State oil and gas Leases PRC 3033 and PRC 3413. No bids were received at the bid opening. The staff obtained a 30-day reduction of the 180-day notice requirement from the lessee and on December 23, 1986, the State Lands Commission directed staff to reoffer the royalty oil produced from these leases.

A Notice Inuiting Bids was published in the Orange County Register and sent to all known interested parties. The bid opening was held on January 9, 1987. Results of the bidding are shown or Exhibit "A", on which the highest responsible bidder is identified.

Staff has reviewed the bids submitted, and recommends the awarding of the Royalty Oil Sales Contract for the royalty crude oil produced from State oil and gas Leases PRC 3033 and
