### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. On May 24, 1984, the Commission, pursuant to the provisions of the CEQA, considered and adepted a Proposed Negative Declaration (ND 358, State Clearinghouse 84020113), for the program under which issuance of this permit is proposed. The Commission found, based on its record, that there was no substantial evidence that the program, as revised and approved, would have a significant effect on the environment. (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15074(b)).
- This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the person nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the permit as part of the program for the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

- 3. FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY AS PROPOSED IS CONSISTENT WITH THE USE CLASSIFICATIONS DESIGNATED FOR THE LANDS PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370. ET SEQ.
- 4. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO ECOSYSTEMS MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATES, INC. OF A NON-EXCLUSIVE GENERAL PERMIT TO CONDUCT GEOPHYSICAL SURVEYS FOR THE PERIOD DECEMBER 23, 1986 THROUGH MAY 31, 1987 WITHIN PERMIT REGIONS I, II, III AND IV AS DEFINED ON EXHIBIT "A" HERETO.
