AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 0.186-acre area of tide and submerged land, located in the San Joaquin River at

Acker Island, San Joaquin Courty.

LAND USE:

Maintenance of boating and barge facilities;

and maintenance of an underground power line.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period:

15 years beginning

November 21, 1984.

Public liability insurance: Combined single

limit coverage of \$506,000.

Special:

The permit is conditioned on the consent of a littoral owner as to any structure located adjacent to littoral

upland.

The permit restricts the use of the facilities for

residential purposes.

CONSIDERATION:

\$366.52 per annum, as to docks, a barge and piling; and \$100 per annum, as to an underground power line; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental

on each fifth anniversary of the permit.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The subject boating facilities are utilized noncommercially as customer accommodation facilities in the operation of a restaurant/lounge business on the upland known as Lost Isle Marina. The underground power line provides electric energy to the site. These are long standing trespass facilities coming under the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities, 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(a)(2).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300, and 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the activity is consistent with its use classification.

#### LAND DESCRIPTION

All that tide and submerged land in the bed of the San Joaquin River lying immediately beneath the structures associated with Lost Isle Marina along the northwest shore of Acker Island, San Joaquin County, California, said structures lying northwesterly and waterward of the land described in the Grant Deed recorded November 21, 1984, in the San Joaquin County Recorders Office, Recorders No. 84079021, said structures to include existing docks, pilings, a barge, an underground powerline across the San Joaquin River from Acker Island to McDonaid Tract, and a pier adjacent to McDonaid Tract, TOGETHER WITH necessary use areas extending no more than 10 feet form the extremities of all said structures but the pilings.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the San Joaquin River.
