OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. This application has been submitted to the Commission in connection with events sponsored by the Sacramento Water Festival
 - Association. The City of Sacramento is a co-applicant and co-sponsor of the event.

The Sacramento Water Festival is a non-profit entertainment event that incorporates the elements of community-civic water events and competition on the International Outboard Grand Prix boat races.

The Festival will take place July 3, 4 and 5, 1987, on the Sacramento River, south of Tower Bridge to the Pioneer Bridge. Activities include aquatic demonstrations and competition in water activities.

Equipment will consist of portable cranes used to put boats in water and temporary docks for boats to start from. All equipment is not permanent and will be removed after the event, leaving the site in its natural condition.

Floating buoys will be dropped into the river July 2nd anchored by cinder blocks. Both cinder blocks and buoys will be pulled out of the water on Monday, July 6th.

Floating docks 4' x 180' to be used as "staging area", will be installed on July 2nd and removed on July 6th.

 Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the starf has determined that this activity is exempt

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from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15304(e).


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
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
