AWARD OF ROYALTY OIL SALES CONTRACT, STATE OIL AND GAS LEASES PRO 3133, PRC 3150, PRC 4000 AND PRC 1824, CARPINTERIA - SUMMERLAND OFFSHORE FIELDS, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

On April 23, 1987, the State Lands Commission authorized the sale of royalty crude oil from one State oil and gas lease in the Wilmington Oil Field. Los Angeles County, four State oil and gas Leases in the Carpinteria - Summerland Offshrre Fields, Samta Barbara County and two State oil and gas Leases in the Ellicod Offshore Oil Field, Santa Barbara County. State oil and gas Leases PRC 3133, PRC 3150, PRC 4000, PRC 1824, Carpinteria - Summerland Offshore Fields, Santa Barbara County were several of the leases for which the Commission authorized the sale of royalty crude oil. The royalty oil sales contract for these leases expired on March 1, 1987.

MacMillan Ring Free Oil Company was purchasing this oil and was paying the State a bonus of \$0.816 per barrel above the Base Price equal to the highest price posted by Cheuron, U.S.A., Inc., for oil of like gravity on the day of delivery in the Carpinteria - Summerland Offshore Fields. The State's share of product on from these leases is approximately 480 barrels per day of between 27° - 36° API gravity crude oil.

A Notice Inviting Bids was published in the <u>Santa Barbara</u> <u>News-Press</u> on April 28, 1987 and sent to all known interested parties. Bids were received and opened on May 13, 1987. Exhibit "A" shows the results of the bidding.

Fiscal and Legal reviews of the submitted bid material were done by the State Lands Commission Auditing and Legal Units respectively. Based on the results of the reviews, the highest responsible bidder has been identified on Exhibit "A".

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
