REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR SERVICES FOR THE 1987-88 FISCAL YEAR

Commission approval is required on all contacts that need Department of General Services - Legal Office approval. The following agreements budgeted for FY 87-88 are presanted for your approval.

1. Lobel Novins Lamont and Flug

Contractor will represent the State Lands Commission on an ongoing basis in Washington D.C. at meetings, conferences, congressional and administrative hearings on matters affecting the Commission. The Department of Justice has approved entering into this agreement. Sole Source for an amount not-to-exceed \$100,000.

- <u>Blueprint, Reprographics</u> Contractor will provide reproduction services for maps, drawings and related materials for the Sacramento office. Estimated cost \$25,000.
- <u>Helicopter Service</u> Contractor will provide helicopter flight service for aerial observation of oil and gas operations in the Santa Barbara Channel. Estimated cost \$20,000.
- <u>Department of Justice</u> Contractor to provide legal consultative services concerning the Commission's operations under Chapter 29/56 1st E.S., Chapter 138/64, 1st E.S., the Alamitos Bay investigation for an amount not-to-exceed \$324,000.
- <u>Health and Welfare Data Center</u> Contractor to provide data processing services associated with CALSTARS processing requirements for an amount not-to-exceed \$35,000.

- Office of Planning and Research Contractor to review oil and gas projects on State-owned coastal waters and the Federal Outer Continental Shelf for an amount not-to-exceed \$36,000.
- 7. <u>Reclamation Board</u> Contractor to reimburse the Commission for miscellaneous technical and accounting services performed on Reclamation Board oil and gas programs for an amount nct-to-exceed \$25,000.
- State Controllers Office Contractor to provide investigative services for illegal and non-permitted activities on lands under the jurisdiction of the Commission for an amount not-to-exceed \$50,000.
- Maintenance of Word Processing Equipment Contractor to provide maintenance on the Commission's Wang word processing system. Estimated cost \$20,600.
- 10. <u>Federal Data Reproduction and Interpretation</u> Contractor to provide reproduction and interpretation of data acquired from the Federal lessees pursuant to Section 8(g) of the Outer Continental Shelf Act, Amendments. Estimated cost \$148,000.
- School Land Timber Appraisal Contractor to prepare a timber appraisal of selected school lands in Northern California. Estimated cost \$50,000.
- 12. <u>Insurance Consultant</u> Contractor to provide technical and consultative services and prepare a risk analysis of the Commission's leasing program. Estimated cost \$50,000.
- Systems Safety Contractor to review the systems safety programs of offshore oil platforms. Estimated cost \$56,000.
