Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, existing facility, 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(2)(2)).

- 2. The project is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370 and is classified in a use category "8" which authorizes Limited Use. The project, as proposed, will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.
- Section 2 of the permit conforms to the Lyon/Fogerty decision.
- The Commission at its meeting on November 27, 1978, suspended all leasing for new construction at take Tahoe, except for mooring buoys in designated areas. This action was taken pending completion of an EIR which addresses the cumulative impact of continued construction of piers in take Tahoe. The application herein is for the continued use of an existing pier in the take, and therefore is not subject to the Commission's suspension of leasing activities for new construction.
