AUTHORIZATION FOR BOUNDARY LINE AGREEMENT

APPLICANT:

Charles A. Orwick Route 3, Box 3570

Red Bluff, California 96080

In August 1979, the Tehama County Superior Court quieted the State's title to a 52-acre parcel of land, located along the east bank of the Sacramento River, approximately ten miles north of Red Bluff. This parcel, which had been used by the public for years as a fishing and camping site, was claimed by Charles Orwick, owner of adjacent lands to the east, on the theory that it had accreted from the Sacramento River and attached to its east bank. The court agreed with the State's position that the parcel in question formed as an island within the Sacramento River and consequently belongs to the State pursuant to Section 1016 of the Civil Code. The court also held that the public has an easement across Mr. Orwick's lands based on implied dedication to this parcel from an adjacent public highway.

Following the entry of judgment it was discovered that the description of the boundary line between the lands of Charles A. Orwick and the State-owned parcel contained some inaccuracies and did not conform to the court's holding. On June 21, 1984, the Commission authorized its staff to correct the errors in the description of the boundary line and prepare and file a record of survey map with the Tehama County Recorder. The revised map was recorded on August 13, 1984.

Since then. Mr. Orwick has agreed to enter into a boundary line agreement with the Commission, accepting the Commission's record of survey as the boundary between the respective interests.
