OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Lessee was granted a 49-year General Permit - Public Agency Use for operation and maintenance of a public use recreational pier in 1969. Over the years, numerous requests for occasional non-recreational use of the pier have been made of Lessee. Lessee has now requested an amendment to the permit to allow Lessee to grant such use. Staff recommends the amendment to eliminate the time, expense, and delays of State Lands Commission staff processing of every non-recreational use request. The County of Santa Barbara has approved the change in use, conditional upon such use not exceeding 60 times per year. Lessee has agreed to limit approval of non-recreational uses to no more than 60 per year.
- 2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$2,943.
- 3. Due to the minimum staff time expended in processing the amendment, staff recommends a waiver of the processing fees.
- 4. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

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EXHIBIT "A"

LAND DESCRIPTION

A strip of tide and submerged land 50 feet wide in the Pacific Ocean at Gaviota Pier, Santa Barbara County, California, said strip lying 25 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

BEGINNING at a point in the centerline of Gauiota Pier from which USC&GS triangulation station "Tank" bears N89°31'18"E a distance of 3,150.53 feet; thence from said point of beginning SO6°05'37"E along the centerline of Gauiota Pier and the prolongation thereof a distance of 600 feet.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the Pacific Ocean.

This description is based on the California Coordinate System, Zone 5.
